## What is the benefit of an Adult Camp?

The camp provides all participants regardless of their level of experience, amateur or professional, an opportunity to enjoy intensive dressage instruction and training in a fun and educational environment. Riders of all backgrounds, levels and interests are welcome.

Camp will consist of 27 riders and their horses and an unlimited number of campers without horses and auditors. Campers historically have come from Kansas, Missouri, Arkansas, Oklahoma and Nebraska. Each rider will receive both a group lesson (consisting of three riders) and a private lesson daily from USDF certified instructors. Nightly lessons, demonstrations and/or question & answer sessions will also be conducted. All participants and their horses are housed on campus, eat at the university cafeteria and all instruction is conducted at the university facilities comprised of two large indoor arenas with seating for auditors. Lectures are conducted in university classrooms. The camp also provides a reasonable cost format for this level of intensive instruction.

## KCDS offers 2 Grants covering 50% of the fees for first time Camp attendees!!!

Open to KCDS members, KCDS is providing two grants of \$375 to help send two members to their first camp. The grants are funded by the KCDS Endowment Fund. Recipients of the grants will have to keep a journal and then write an article for The Extension and the KCDS website about their experience at camp. To apply, please submit a short essay with your camp application outlining how the grants will help you with your dressage education and goals. Please include information about your participation in KCDS including volunteering and service to the dressage community. Grant applications are due March 15<sup>th</sup> and will be awarded by May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012
